[BEFORE YOU VISIT]

PRE-FIELD TRIP CHECKLIST

- ✓ Divide your class into the number of groups outlined on the confirmation form with at least one adult accompanying each group of students.
- ✓ Review with your students that any food, drink, chewing gum, ink pens and water bottles are not allowed on the tours. All artistic supplies will be provided by Museum.
- ✓ Remind your students not to touch any of the art objects, furniture and sculpture on view. Even the cleanest hands leave fingerprints that are filled with salts, oils, and acids that are damaging to works of art over time.
- ✓ Extend all rules of behavior used in your classroom to the Museum. Courtesies such as talking one at a time, raising hands and using "indoor" voices are all appropriate when touring the Museum.
- ✓ The use of cameras and/or video equipment is not allowed in the Museum. These of course may be used while on the grounds or in the Education Center.
