Avery Papers (1768-1865)

HISTORY OF THE COLLECTION: The Avery family were farmers in East Lyme. Jonathan Avery purchased land from Moses Noyes in the 1760's. His son, Abraham Avery increased the family's land holdings. Thomas Avery, son of Abraham, farmed the land until at least the mid-1860s. These papers, which largely contain land deeds conveying land to the above Avery's, were given to the Society by Mrs. G. K. Holmes of Cornwall Bridge, Connecticut in 1977.
