Mary D. Connors Scrapbook Collection: Boxes 1-5

Mary D. Connors, wife of David J. Connors, mother of Mary Ann Connors and James Connors, served as Town Secretary for 23 years, retiring in 1953. Her work as secretary and bookkeeper for the town began when E. D. Caulkins was first selectman and continued through the terms of Howard. W. Tooker and James A. Gould. In 1971, having served as clerk of the Probate Court and clerk of the Trial Justice Court, she ran for the Board of Selectmen but stepped down to break a tie vote. She lived for many years with her family on Lyme Street across from the Phoebe Griffin Noyes Library in what was known as the Charles L. Morley house, then moved to McCurdy Road. After 1968 she devoted much of her time to painting in the studio behind her home. A member of the Lower Valley Art Guild and the New London Art Students' League, she exhibited in the Old Lyme Art Center. She recalls that her first job was as a babysitter for noted Lyme artist Guy Wiggins.

Her scrapbooks contain miscellaneous clippings from local newspapers, many concerned with artists, Lyme Art Association, Lyme Historical Society, and Florence Griswold House, as well as with local events in Old Lyme and surrounding towns; also family correspondence, greeting cards and miscellaneous family papers.
