Champion Papers (1825-1871)

Note: Sylvester Champion [1788-1868], the oldest son of Capt. Roswell Champion, had a large farm in South Lyme near Four Mile River. In 1813 he married Nancy Miller Chadwick. In 1836 he served in the state assembly, and he always identified proudly with the Connecticut militia. Champion drowned trying to cross the Niantic River in a gale.
