

DIRECTIONS

The Museum is located in Southeastern Connecticut, halfway between New York and Boston.

Traveling on I-95 South from Mystic or Rhode Island:

Take EXIT 70; at bottom of exit ramp, turn RIGHT onto Lyme Street. The Museum is the second building on the LEFT

Traveling on I-95 North from New Haven

Come over the bridge at the mouth of the Connecticut River. Stay in the RIGHT lane. Take EXIT 70; at the bottom of the exit ramp, turn LEFT at light onto Route 156. Turn RIGHT at second traffic light onto Halls Road. Take Halls Road to the end. At the end, take a LEFT at the light onto Lyme Street. The Museum is the second building on the LEFT.

Traveling from I-91 and Route 9 North from Hartford

There are brown state highway signs marking the way. When coming from Hartford, take I-91 South to Route 9 South. Follow Route 9 to the end and get on I-95 going North and follow the directions above.

WEDDINGS ON THE ADRIAN P. MOORE GARDEN TERRACE

The Garden Terrace is an ideal location for weddings between April and October. Situated behind the Krieble Gallery and adjacent to Marshfield, the Terrace offers a private setting for a wedding, overlooking the river. Your guests can enjoy cocktails on the veranda and lawns of Marshfield before moving under the tent for dinner and dancing. The Museum provides the use of the modern bathroom facilities (handicapped accessible) in the Krieble Gallery and you provide the tent, tables and chairs, dance floor, dinner and glassware, and linens. A Bride's Dressing Room is available and you are welcome to have your photographs taken in the gardens, or along the river.



PRIVATE PARTIES AT MARSHFIELD
