FloGris Art Call 2024 for *naqutiwowok / continuance: Connecticut's Tribal Communities Create*

What is this project? People from Connecticut's five recognized tribes are collaborating to curate an exhibition that will be on view at the FloGris Museum in conjunction with the exhibition *Native Prospects: Indigeneity and Landscape*, curated by Dr. Scott Manning Stevens.

The working group developing the concept for the exhibition *naqutiwowok / continuance: Connecticut's Tribal Communities Create* encourages prospective artists to consider how their work can relate to the fall/winter seasons during which the show will take place.

- Concepts such as gathering, resiliency, connecting, relating, walking (land), paddling (water), repairing, continuation, sustaining, warming, and changing are offered as food for thought and inspiration as you consider the fall/winter timing of the exhibition.
- The planners seek contributions to the exhibition that express thoughts about indigeneity and landscape from the perspective of this area's people.

The exhibition's success depends on the generous participation of members of Connecticut's tribal communities.
